Medical Resources

Free Medical Clinic

Sponsored by The Vine Church, 504 Marshallville Highway, Perry. 1st and 3rd Thursdays of each month between 6 and 8 p.m. Call 318-4781 for an appointment. Walk-Ins are accepted but seen on a first come, first serve basis based on open slots in the appointment schedule. (We do not do: Camp, School, or DOT Physicals, refill medications we have not prescribed, OB/GYN exams, well baby checks, treat chronic pain, prescribe narcotics or draw blood.) Feed Center Outreach Health Clinic

The clinic sees patients on an appointment-only basis. Those seeking medical attention need to register on Mondays and Wednesdays from 1 to 3 p.m. at the Feed Center Outreach, located on 313 Carver Drive in Fort Valley. Applications can be filled out during these times as well appointments made for clinical services. Clinic Hours are on Tuesday and Thursday evenings 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. Previously qualified patients seen during clinic hours by appointment only. Patients must be between ages 18-64, employed, and uninsured. Family's gross income must be 200% of poverty level or less. Patients must provide proof of family income, a picture I.D., and a social security card. For more information, visit the website: www.feedcenterministry.org, or call 478-825-0038.

Macon Volunteer Clinic (Free Medical Clinic)

Corner of Rogers Ave and Ingleside Ave. Eligibility guidelines for Macon Volunteer Clinic include: must be employed, live in Bibb County, be between the ages of 18-64, must be uninsured (no Medicaid, no Medicare, no 'clinic card' and no private or employer provided health insurance or VA benefits). Patients must provide a valid social security number. Income limit guidelines apply. Call 755-1110 for hours and services. Patients must be screened before seeing a physician. Screening Hours on Thursday from 2 – 4 pm (please arrive before 3:30). Bring a picture ID, social security card, letter from employer stating that you do work and do not have health insurance, six payroll slips, two utility bills, and your current 1040 form. Medical Clinic Hours – by appointment only are Monday 5 – 7 pm, Tuesday 5 – 8 pm, Wednesday 9 – 12 noon, and Thursday 9 – 12 noon. Services include physician visits, non-narcotic prescription medication, laboratory analysis, x-rays, eye exams, limited dental care and cancer screenings such as mammograms, Pap smears and colonoscopies. All services are

Rehoboth Life Care Ministries Dental Clinic

3208 US Highway 41, Byron. 2nd and 4th Friday of each month from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. For appointments, call 478-953-7770. Patients must live in Houston, Peach, Taylor, or Crawford counties. Requirements: a utility bill for proof of residency within the serviced area, a photo ID, and patients must be uninsured. The family's gross income must be at 150% or less of the federal poverty level. Clients must bring with them documentation which applies for proof of household income (for example, W2 or the most recent year's income tax return, last three current & consecutive pay check stubs for everyone employed in the household, recent government benefits letter showing current amounts of benefits or IRS 1040 Form).
